



Standard Staircase



REMEMBER!

Keep your measurements for each section of your staircase separately, never add them all together.

Your Measurements:

If you are measuring multiple sections, please use a separate sheet for each section.

Section: _____

A

This measurement will measure the length of handrail and baserail that you will need for the particular run you are measuring. This should be measured between the newel posts, ignoring the newel caps.

B

This measurement will measure the going of the stairs. Along with measurement A, this will help to determine the pitch (or angle) of your staircase and ultimately, the amount of spindles required for your stairs. Unfortunately most houses have differing pitches of staircase, as houses have been built over many different decades, with no standardisation in staircases.

C

This measurement will measure the length of handrail and baserail that you will need for the particular landing run that you are measuring. This should be measured between the newel posts, ignoring the newel caps.
